

MedaPhor demonstrates revolutionary ultrasound training system at the Arab Health Fair

MedaPhor was delighted to be chosen to be part of Lord Darzi's exhibition tour at the 2011 Arab Health exhibition in Dubai last month.

As part of the Welsh Assembly Government's pavilion, showcasing industry leading technology from Wales, MedaPhor's innovative new ScanTrainer ultrasound training simulator was chosen as an excellent representative of the quality products and services produced within Wales.

MedaPhor, who won the MediWales' Innovation award in 2010, talked with Lord Darzi about their ScanTrainer – a virtual 'real feel' ultrasound training simulator that provides students with a 24/7 educationally driven training programme that replicates the real scan experience. Trainees can literally 'feel' what they see on the computer screen in order to develop the complex mix of cognitive skills and eye-hand movement coordination; but without the need for an ultrasound machine, a patient and considerably reduced direct supervision by an expert.

The system, which is selling well in the UK, is now being rolled out overseas as MedaPhor looks to sign up distributors in regions such North America, Europe and the Middle East.
